

# Surveying Courses Worksheet

This Surveying Courses Worksheet must be completed by applicants seeking eventual registration in Ohio as a Professional Surveyor who do **not** have a B.S. degree in surveying. Ohio R.C. section 4733.11 (B) allows an applicant with an EAC/ABET-accredited B.S. degree in Civil Engineering (B.S.C.E.) to be eligible for eventual registration as a Professional Surveyor if the applicant has completed 16 semester hours (or 24 quarter hours) of Board-approved surveying courses, including at least 6 semester hours (or 8 quarter hours) of courses in property surveying. The course category requirements are listed below. **This form must be accompanied by original transcripts showing a B.S.C.E. degree and completion of the courses listed herein.** Underline the surveying courses on your submitted transcripts.
