State Board Accepts Settlement Agreement

At its meeting on July 22, 2009 the Ohio State Board of Registration for Professional Engineers and Surveyors accepted a settlement agreement from Carmen Conglose Jr., P.S. a resident of Youngstown, Ohio.

In June 2008 the Board received information indicating that Conglose, the former Deputy Director of Public Works in Youngstown, Ohio, had [REDACTED]

Ohio Revised Code Sections 4733.20 (A)(2), [REDACTED] and (5) and OAC 4733-[REDACTED] and 4733-[REDACTED].

The settlement agreement precludes Carmen Conglose Jr. from any further violations of federal, state and local laws, and all laws and rules governing the practice of surveying. In the settlement agreement Conglose agreed to pay a \$2000.00 fine and receive a public reprimand.
